

REGULATIONS
of the Open Championship for the Prizes
of the President of the Republic of Belarus among men
World SAMBO Cup

1. Goals and objectives

- 1.1. Popularisation and promotion of SAMBO in the Republic of Belarus and worldwide.
- 1.2. Strengthening of the international sports and cultural ties.
- 1.3. Promotion of healthy lifestyles.

2. Competitions (hereinafter referred to as Tournament) management

- 2.1. General management of the preparation and holding of the Tournament is arranged by the Ministry of Sports and Tourism of the Republic of Belarus and SAMBO Federation of the Republic of Belarus.
- 2.2 Direct responsibility for conducting the Tournament is rested on the chief panel of referees appointed by the FIAS.

3. Dates and venue of the Tournament

The Tournament is held from 19 to 21 February 2014 in the city of Minsk (Republic of Belarus), at Palace of Sport Cultural and Sports Republican Unitary Enterprise.

February 19	Day of arrival
17.00-18.00	Weigh-in in all weight categories.
February 20	
9.00	Beginning of the competitions in all weight categories
17.00	Solemn Opening
17.30	Finals, awarding the winners and medalists.
February 21	Departure of delegations.

4. Conditions of participation in the Tournament.

- 4.1. The right to participate in competitions is granted only to those athletes who meet the below mentioned requirements:
- 4.2. Athletes with a FIAS **license book**, who have a 2014 FIAS **annual fee** payment note (athletes who come to participate in the Tournament, but fail to pay the license in due time, shall pay the annual license (25 US Dollars) on-site). The athletes, who do not have a license book, can buy it from the Treasurer or a person authorised by the Treasurer for 10 US Dollars.
- 4.3. Athletes who have the athlete's **health insurance**. (According to the law of the Republic of Belarus on the stay of foreign citizens in the Republic of Belarus, all persons coming into the country are required to have an insurance policy for the period of stay in the Republic of Belarus).
- 4.4. On arrival Heads of delegations shall submit the following documents to the Secretariat: application, passport or identity card, FIAS license with annual fee payment note.

5. Conditions and procedure of the Tournament.

- 5.1. The tournament is held in accordance with SAMBO applicable rules and FIAS regulations.
- 5.2. The Organising Committee ensures first aid to all participants of the delegations.

6. Awarding.

- 6.1. Athletes who get a medal place are awarded with diplomas and medals of the corresponding degrees and prizes.

7. Financial Terms.

- 7.1. The expenses for accommodation and meals (breakfast and dinner) from 19 to 21 February 2014 are covered by the Organising Committee, according to the invitations sent.
- 7.2. The expenses for accommodation and meals in excess of the allocated quota are paid by sending organisations.
- 7.3. Heads of delegations shall settle all financial obligations with the Organising Committee on the arrival day and fulfill all the requirements of accreditation.

8. Miscellaneous.

8.1. The final date of confirmation is February 1, 2014.

8.2. If members of your delegation need visa support for arrival in the Republic of Belarus, you should provide copies of passports and data about location of the consulate where you will receive a visa to the Belarusian SAMBO Federation.
