Regulations of the World Sambo Championships 2017 (M&W, Combat SAMBO)

1. General terms

- 1.1. The World Sambo Championships 2017 (M&W, Combat SAMBO) (hereinafter - the Championship) shall be held in accordance with the FIAS Regulations for Organising and Holding of the Official FIAS Competitions (sport and organizational rules) and the International SAMBO Competition Rules.
- 1.2. The Championship is organized to define the strongest athletes in corresponding age group as well as to promote and develop SAMBO worldwide, and to strengthen the international relations.

2. Competitions' organizers

- 2.1. General management of the organization and holding of the Championship shall be the responsibility of the International Sambo Federation (FIAS) together with the All-Russian Sambo Federation and the Ministry of Sports of the Russian Federation.

3. Dates and venue

- 3.1. The Championship shall be held from 09 to 13 of November 2017.
- 3.2. Competition venue: Sochi, Krasnodar Region, «Iceberg» Sports Palace.
- 3.3. Accreditation will take place at the conference hall of the «Iceberg» Sports Palace.
- 3.4. Participants will be accommodated in «Barkhatnye Sezony» Hotel: 354053, Adler district, Sochi, Russia.

4. Terms of participation

- 4.1. The National sambo federations affiliated to FIAS have the right to take part in the Competitions. The NSF should pay the FIAS annual membership fee before the competitions in order to be able to take part in the competitions.
Registration of athletes is made by means of the FIAS online license and competitions registration system <http://registration.sambo-fias.org/>. Each National Sambo Federation received an individual

login and password for their accounts. Admission of athletes to the competitions is made only by means of FIAS online license and competitions registration system. The cost of license is 35 USD. 4.2. Weight categories:

Men	57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, +100 kg
Women	52, 56, 60, 64, 68, 72, 80, +80 kg
Combat Sambo	57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, +100 kg

5. Technical terms

- 5.1. The Championship shall be held in accordance with FIAS Sports and Organization Rules and the International SAMBO Competition Rules. Officiating of the competition shall be entrusted to the panel of referees approved by the Chairman of FIAS Referees Committee.
- 5.2. Only international category referees, with the FIAS license 2017, who were appointed by the Chairman of FIAS Referees Committee, will be able to officiate the competition.
- 5.3. The Repechage system from finalists is applied. Team medal count is conducted according to the Olympic principle.
- 5.4. Participation in the competition is allowed upon the presentation of the medical insurance for each athlete (not less than the equivalent of 10000 US dollars), which should be submitted to the Organising Committee of the competitions on the accreditation day. Competition participants should be insured at the expense of the sending organization.
- 5.5. The Organising Committee guarantees to provide all the participants with the first aid (if necessary).
- 5.6. According to the Organising and Holding of the Official FIAS Competitions – Appendix 7 (page 24) each competitor is obliged to have a backnumber comprising his last name and his National Olympic Committee abbreviation on the back of his uniforms (red & blue). The backnumber should be ordered only from the licensed supplier: Asociatia Combat Sport Equipment www.sambobacknumber.com
- 5.7. During the accreditation, all the countries delegates should provide the Organizing Committee with a short version (not more than 30 seconds) of corresponding national anthem in electronic format and two national flags.

6. Anti-Doping

- 6.1. Doping controls will be conducted by the National Anti-Doping Organization officially recognized by WADA. The selection of the athletes will be carried out in accordance with the FIAS Anti-Doping Rules 2015 which are based on 2015 WADA Code. The selected athletes will be accompanied by an official representative of the Organization since the moment they receive the notice until their arrival to the doping control station. A person of the athlete's choice (his/her representative in accordance with the FIAS Anti-Doping Regulations of 2015) can accompany him/her. In case the Organizing Committee does not provide accreditation card with photography the selected athletes are required to provide to the Doping Control Officer a valid passport or other identification document with photography.
- 6.2. The teams representatives must carefully plan their departure date and time after the competition taking into account that the athletes may be chosen for the Doping Control.

7. Entries

- 7.1. Completed entry forms duly sealed and signed by the NSF President or Secretary General shall be sent to the Championship's Organizing Committee to the following email address: eurosambo@gmail.com and the copy to the following FIAS address: info@sambo-fias.com:

- ❖ Entry № 1 – Preliminary form should be sent **by September 15**
- ❖ Entry № 2 – Visa form should be sent **by September 30**
- ❖ Registration in the FIAS database should be sent **by September 30**
- ❖ Entry № 4.1 and 4.2 – Hotel booking, flight details (arrival/departure) **by September 30.**

In case of non-submission of the entry forms in a due time to the Organising Committee the delegations shall solve transfer and accommodation issues autonomously and shall pay a lump-sum accreditation fee in the amount of 150 US dollars per person.

7.3. Mass media representatives will pass additional accreditation process at the official FIAS website: <http://sambo-fias.org> in the section Press Centre – Press Accreditation not later than August 20.

8. Financial conditions

- 8.1. Each delegation member must pay the Organizational Fee to the Organizing Committee at the amount of 100 USD per day (accommodation and meals, 2 times a day). Minimum accommodation period is two days.
- 8.2. All athletes of the National Sambo Federation in line with the submitted entry forms according to the present Regulations (no later than September 30, 2017) will be provided with the accommodation and meal (2 times a day) at the expense of the Organising Committee.
- 8.3. Transfer fee from Sochi airport or railway station to the official Championship hotel and back and from official hotel to the competition venue and back is 20 USD for each delegation member during competitions. The costs should be paid at the expense of the NSF.
- 8.4. In case of individual accommodation (independently from the Organizing Committee) each national federation shall pay an accreditation fee in the amount 150 USD for each team member (accommodation, meals, transfer are not included in this fee) to the Organizing Committee to cover the cost of championships organization.
- 8.5. All the Championship participants travel to the competition venue at the expense of their sending organizations.
- 8.6. The Heads of delegations shall settle all financial issues and meet accreditation requirements on the day of arrival. The Payment to be made on site in US dollars. It is also possible to pay in Euro according to the cross-rate during the payment day.
- 8.7. The Organizing Committee shall provide with accommodation and meals: FIAS President, FIAS Secretary General, FIAS Executive Committee members, Chairman of the Referees Committee, Chief Referee, Chief Secretary and 24 referees according to the official designation.
- 8.8. FIAS shall cover the cost of travel, meals, and accommodation expenses of the Chief Referee, Chief Secretary, Chief Secretary's assistant and 6 referees. FIAS shall pay the work of the Chairman of the Referees Commission, Chief Referee and Chief Secretary at the rate 100 US dollars for each day of the competitions, including the days of arrival and departure. FIAS shall pay the work of 24 referees at the rate of 50 US dollars for each day of competitions.

9. Awarding

9.1. Prize-winning athletes shall be awarded with medals and diplomas.

- 9.2. Red sambo uniform is required at the official ceremonies.
- 9.3. During the awarding ceremony national anthem will be played along with raising a flag.
- 9.4. Three best teams, according to the competition results shall be awarded with cups (Men's and Women's teams in Sports Sambo, Men in Combat Sambo).
