# REGULATIONS MASTERS WORLD SAMBO CHAMPIONSHIPS OCTOBER 20-23, 2017 THESSALONIKI, GREECE

#### 1. MANAGEMENT OF COMPETITION

- 1.1 Masters World SAMBO Championships 2017 (hereinafter referred to as the World SAMBO Championships) shall be held in accordance with the FIAS Regulations on Preparation and Staging of the Official Competitions (sports and organizational rules) and the International SAMBO Competitions Rules.
- 1.2 World SAMBO Championships shall be held in order to decide on the winner in the corresponding age groups as well as to promote and develop SAMBO worldwide, and strengthen the international relations.

#### 2. DATES AND VENUE

- 2.1 The World SAMBO Championships shall be held from October 20 to 23, 2017.
- 2.2 Competition venue: PAOK SPORTS ARENA, Address: 12 Str. Antoniou Tritsi, 55510, Thessaloniki, Greece.

## 3. PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS

- 3.1 Those athletes who are affiliated to their National SAMBO Federations are able to participate at the championships.
- 3.2 Athletes should pay the entry fee during the registration to the authorized representative of FIAS at the amount of 35 US dollars.
- 3.3 Athletes shall be obliged to have a doctor's permission for participation in the competition
- 3.4 All the athletes should have sports medical insurance. The Organising Committee will provide an opportunity to effect an insurance policy during accreditation.

## 4. ENTRIES

4.1 National SAMBO Federations shall send completed registration forms with photos to the Organising Committee by September 15, 2017 to the following e-mail: <a href="mailto:sambokurash@yahoo.gr">sambokurash@yahoo.gr</a>

- Annex No. 2 Visa processing form + passport copy;
- Annex No. 3 Information on arrival and departure;
- A photo of each participant for identification (a photo above the waist, without sunglasses and a cap. File size shall be not over I MB, Format: JPG, file name "Country name, participant's name-jpg").
- 4.2 A number of delegation members at the World SAMBO Championships unlimited.

## 5. TECHNICAL CONDITIONS

- 5.1 World SAMBO Championships shall be held in accordance with FIAS Sport and Organization Rules and the International SAMBO Competitions Rules. Refereeing of the competitions shall be entrusted to the panel of referees approved by the Chairman of FIAS Referees Commission.
- 5.2 Only international category referees who were appointed by the Chairman of FIAS Referees Commission are able to referee the competitions. Each referee should have a corresponding license for the current year 2017.

Age-groups: 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-65, over 65.

Weight categories (men): 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, +100 kg.

5.3 Repechage system from finalists is applied what means that a competitor who loses to the pool semifinalists drops into the repechage bracket. Team medal count is conducted according to the gold first ranking system (based first on the number of gold medals, then silver and bronze).

## 6. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

- 6.1 Each participant of the Championships shall meet the financial obligations before the Organising Committee prior to arrival or on the arrival day in Thessaloniki, Greece.
- 6.2 Accommodation and meals (breakfast, dinner) cost 100 US dollars (85 EUR) per day per person.
- 6.3 Official hotel: Santa Beach Hotel (4 stars)
- 6.4 In case of individual reservation of accommodation each national federation shall pay an accreditation fee at the amount of 150 US dollars for each team member (accommodation, meals, transfer are not included in this fee) to the Organizing Committee to cover the cost of organizing the championships.
- 6.5 The official airport of arrival and departure is **MAKEDONIA AIRPORT** in the city of **THESSALONIKI**. The cost of transfer from airport to the official hotel (group transfer) and back and during competitions from the official hotel to the competition venue and back costs 20 Euro for each team member and to be paid by the national federations. Individual transfers can be organized on request and for an extra payment.
- 6.6 The Organizing Committee shall provide with accommodation and meals: FIAS President, Secretary General, Chairman of the Referees Commission, Chief Referee, Chief Secretary and 12 referees.
- 6.7 FIAS covers the work of the Chairman of the Referees Commission, Chief Referee and Chief Secretary at the rate of 100 US dollars for each day of competitions, including the days of arrival and departure. FIAS covers the work of 12 referees at the rate of 50 US dollars for each day of competitions.

# 7. AWARDING

- 7.1 Prize-winning athletes shall be awarded with medals and diplomas.
- 7.2 Red sambo uniform is required at the awarding ceremony.
- 7.3 During the awarding ceremony national anthem will be played along with flying a flag.
