REGULATIONS
XXXV WORLD SPORTS (M&W) AND COMBAT (M) SAMBO CHAMPIONSHIP
FOR ADULTS

10-14 November 2011

Vilnius (Lithuania)

1. Generalities

- 1.1. XXXV World Sports SAMBO (M&W) and Combat SAMBO(M) Championship for adults in 2011 (hereafter – Championship) are held in accordance with Federation Amateur Internationale de SAMBO (FIAS) International SAMBO competitions managing Provisions and International SAMBO competitions rules (sports and combat).
- 1.2. XXXV World Sports SAMBO (M&W) and Combat SAMBO (M) Championship for adults in 2011 are held to popularize and develop SAMBO worldwide, and to consolidate International sports relations.
- 1.3. The hosting organizer of the XXXV World Sports SAMBO(M&W) and Combat SAMBO(M) Championships for adults in 2011 (hereafter – The Championship) is the Lithuanian SAMBO Federation, with support of the Lithuanian Department of Physical Education and Sports, and Vilnius City Municipality. In order to organize and deliver successful Championship they have formed the Championship Organizing Committee (hereafter – the Championship OC).

2. Place and dates

- 2.1. The place: Vilnius (Lithuania), sports venue “**SIEMENS ARENA**” (14 Ozo st., Vilnius, LT-08200, Lithuania, www.siemens-arena.com);
- 2.2. Dates: **from the 10th till the 14th of November 2011**

3. Athletes Participation

- 3.1. National SAMBO Federation can apply only 1 athlete in each discipline, each weight category
- 3.2. Only those athletes who meet the requirements listed below are allowed to participate in the Championship:
- athlete, whose National SAMBO Federation, affiliated to FIAS, duly paid its membership annual fee for the year 2011.
 - athlete, who has the **FIAS license book** with corresponding stamp, confirming 2011 annual license fee (\$25 USD). Those athletes, who arrived to FIAS international competitions and fail to pay the FIAS annual license in due time must pay annual license in the amount of \$25 USD as well as \$25 USD surcharge when accrediting. Those who have not a license book can purchase the corresponding book at the cost of \$10 USD from the Treasurer or his Proxy.
 - athlete, who has a **compulsory health insurance**. (The athletes who do not have compulsory health insurance policies will be provided by Championship Organizing Committee with possibility to purchase the relevant insurance at their own cost when accrediting).

4. Applications for participation

- 4.1. The Delegation maximum quota is 47 persons, which is allocated as follows:

4.2. The National SAMBO federation must submit the completed **Delegation Registration Form** (see Annex 1) of all members of its delegation to the Championship OC before **the 15th of September'2011** to the following e-mail: info@sambo.lt

4.3. The national SAMBO federation must submit the completed **Individual registration forms** (see Annex 2) of each member of its delegation certified with signature of respective person responsible and stamp of the relevant National SAMBO federation with all corresponding materials attached: scanned copy of the page from passport for travel, including the photo of the holder (please indicate the name and surname of the passport holder in the file name); the digital photo "visa" style in JPG. (5 megabytes max) - please indicate the name and surname of the photo holder in the file name, to the Championship OC before **the 15th of September'2011** to the following e-mail: info@sambo.lt. The original of the Individual registration form, with signature and stamp to be submitted when accrediting.

5. Technical terms

5.1. The Championship is held in accordance with the International SAMBO competitions rules (sports and combat) of Federation Amateur Internationale de SAMBO (FIAS) and FIAS International SAMBO competitions managing Provisions

5.2. Weight categories:

Sport SAMBO (men):

52 kg, 57 kg, 62 kg, 68 kg, 74 kg, 82 kg, 90 kg, 100 kg, +100 kg

Sport SAMBO (women):

48 kg, 52 kg, 56 kg, 60 kg, 64 kg, 68 kg, 72 kg, 80 kg, +80 kg

Combat SAMBO (men):

52 kg, 57 kg, 62 kg, 68 kg, 74 kg, 82 kg, 90 kg, 100 kg, +100 kg

5.3. The Championship OC guarantees first aid provision to all members of National SAMBO Federation delegations.

5.4. Team ranking is defined due to the individual results of the athletes of this relevant team.

5.5. Individual contest is held in groups according to the system of eliminations and consolation bouts to be held afterwards.

5.6. Only the international category referees are allowed to judge the competitions

5.7. National SAMBO Federations participating in Championships should provide

Championship OC with 2 national flags (2 m x 1m) and a record of the National anthem on CD.

- 5.8. The athletes who won the prize-winning places shall be awarded with medals and diplomas.
- 5.9. The Teams who took the prize-winning places shall be awarded with cups.
- 5.10. All participants of the Championship shall participate in official ceremonies.
- 5.11. Upon the prizes are presented to appropriate athletes- each corresponding national flag shall be raised, simultaneously with each corresponding national anthem sounding during the ceremony.

6. Financial terms

- 6.1. Heads of sport delegations have to fulfil all financial obligations to the Championship OC on the day of arrival.
- 6.2. National SAMBO Federation has to pay the participation fee in the amount of **\$100 USD** per day per registered delegate to the Championship OC **prior to the 15th of September 2011**. Those National SAMBO Federations, who registered **after the deadline 15th of September 2011**, shall pay participation fee in the amount of **of \$120 USD** per day per registered delegate.

This participation fee covers costs for accommodation at hotels not less than 3 stars service level, 3 times catering, transportation from hotel (and back) to the sports venues and organizational expenses.
- 6.3. Transportation from the airport (or railway station) of Vilnius city to the official Championship hotel and back shall be paid separately upon preliminary agreement with organizers in the amount of **20 \$ USD** per person.
- 6.4. In case any national SAMBO federation reserves accommodation itself, this National SAMBO federation shall pay **100 \$ USD participation fee** per each member of its delegation to the Championship Organizing Committee, which covers the organizational expenses. And this NSF shall provide accommodation, catering, and pay for transfer from the hotels to the sports venues, as well as transportation from airport (railway station) to the hotel (s) and back for its members by itself.
- 6.5. The Championship Organizing Committee covers expenses for accommodation and catering, transfer from Vilnius airport or railway station to the hotel and back, for transportation from the hotel/(place of accommodation) to the competition/(sports) venues, meeting sites and back from 10th of November till 14th for the following persons: FIAS President, Secretary General, Chairman of the FIAS Referee Commission, Chief Referee, Chief Secretary and 20 (twenty) referees of competitions.

- 6.6. The Championship Organizing Committee covers the expenses for transportation of the following persons: Chairman of the FIAS Referee Commission, Chief Referee, Chief Secretary from the capital of the host country to the Vilnius.
- 6.7. The FIAS pays for the work of the following persons: Chairman of the FIAS Referee Commission, Chief Referee and Chief Secretary in the amount of \$100 USD per day (the work of the Chairman of the FIAS Referee Commission, Chief Referee and chief Secretary shall be paid 2 (two) days additionally to the period of competitions) and for the work of 20 referees in the amount of \$50 USD per working day during competitions.
- 6.8. FIAS pays for the work and covers the travel expenses of the FIAS Treasurer.

6.9. **Fines**

In case the delegates of National SAMBO federation did not use the accommodation, reserved by the Championship Organizing Committee, this National SAMBO federation shall pay to the Championship Organizing Committee the **nonrecurring 70 \$ USD fine for each such delegate**

7. Accommodation, catering and transfer

- 7.1. The applications for Accommodation reservation at the official Championship hotel (s) must be sent to the Championship Organizing committee before the **15th of September 2011** to the following e-mail: info@sambo.lt (Annex 3)
- 7.2. All delegates, duly applied by the National SAMBO federations to be provided by the Championship OC with reservation of accommodation at the championship OC hotels not less than 3 stars service level, 3 times catering, transportation from hotel (and back) to the sports venues within the Championship period in Vilnius (Lithuania).
- 7.3. Transportation from the airport (railway station) of Vilnius city to the official Championship hotel and back shall be provided in accordance with the corresponding application form the NFS to the Championship Organizing Committee (Annex 3).
- 7.4. Those national SAMBO federations who wish to reserve accommodation and provide catering transfer from the hotels to the sports venues, as well as transportation from airport (railway station) to the hotel (s) and back by themselves, must inform the Championship OC of their decision before **the 15th of September 2011**, providing it with the corresponding form completed (Annex 1).

8. Accreditation

- 8.1. All members of the delegation of National SAMBO federation shall be accredited to the Championship.
- 8.2. The accreditation to the Championship shall be executed at the Hotel "Panorama". The

- 8.3. In order to be accredited the delegate must provide to Championship OC the following: the Individual registration form, certified with the signature of the person responsible and the stamp of the national SAMBO federation, passport, the license book (for athletes); medical insurance police (for athletes).
- 8.4. The Media, who wish to be accredited must send their Individual registration forms completed to the Championship OC no later **than 1st of October** (see Annex 2).

9. Doping Tests

- 9.1. The Championship Organizing Committee shall conduct the random doping tests among the medalists. Athletes to be subjected to doping control tests will be determined after the final bouts.
- 9.2. The afterward doping tests result analysis and management shall be executed strictly in accordance with the FIAS Anti-doping provisions and regulations of WADA World Anti-doping Code

10. Miscellaneous

- 10.1. All members of the national SAMBO federation delegation shall be provided with visa support, needed to obtain visa in relevant consulates and Embassies of Lithuania (please, consider that the passport shall be valid not **less than 3 months** after the last date of your visit to championship).
- 10.2. The correspondence regarding the planning, organization and delivery of the XXXV World sports (M&W) and Combat (M) SAMBO championship for Adults shall be forwarded to the Championship Organizing Committee.

11. Media

- 11.1. Only the Media, accredited by the Championship Organizing Committee are allowed to participate in the competitions or enter the press center.
- 11.2. Not later than 1 week after the Championship if over the accredited Media is obligatory to provide the copies of all shot materials in original quality to the Championship Organizing Committee. The Championship Organizing committee leaves the right to use the received materials due to his intention observing on non-commercial basis, whereas the OC will indicate the name of the relevant photographer or operator (other Media), that provided the materials duly. Please, consider that all other usage of the photos or videos of the Championship is the subject to approval with organizers.
