DSI Dutch Open SAMBO 2026

Dalfsen, The Netherlands

7 - 10 March 2026

1. General terms.

- 1.1 The Dutch Open SAMBO 2026 shall be held in accordance with the current International Sambo Rules approved by the International Sambo Federation (FIAS).
- 1.2 The Dutch Open SAMBO 2026 will be held in accordance with the current regulations of the International Sambo Federation (FIAS).
- 1.3 The Dutch Open SAMBO 2026 will be organized by the Dutch Sambo Federation (DSF) / Budo Promotion Ommen (BPO).
- 1.4 The Dutch Open SAMBO 2026 is held to popularize and develop the sport of sambo in Europe and to strengthen international sporting relations between the members of the International Sambo Federation (FIAS) in Europe and the World.

2. Competition organizers.

- 2.1 General management of the organization and holding of the Dutch Open SAMBO 2026 shall be the responsibility of the Dutch Sambo Federation (DSF) / Budo Promotion Ommen (BPO).

3. Dates and venue.

- 3.1 The Dutch Open SAMBO 2026 shall be held from March 7 to 10, 2026.
- 3.2 Competition venue: Sportshall 'Trefkoele Plus', Ruigedoornstraat 108, 7721 BR Dalfsen (NL)
- 3.3 Accreditation of the participants of the Dutch Open SAMBO 2026 will be held at the sportshall.
- 3.4 The participants of the Dutch Open SAMBO 2026 should find accommodation themselves.
- 3.5 The referees who will come to help make the Dutch Open SAMBO 2026 a success will be accommodated in Emsland Sport en Recreatie, Emslandweg 17, 7731 RP Ommen, www.emsland-ommen.nl.

4. Terms of participation.

- 4.1 The National Sambo Federations (NSF), affiliated with the International Sambo Federation (FIAS), have the right to participate in the Dutch Open SAMBO 2026.
- 4.2 Registration of delegations to the Dutch Open SAMBO 2026 shall be done through the electronic system SMOOTHCOMP: <https://dutch-sambo-federation.smoothcomp.com/en/event/27727>
- 4.3 The deadline for registration in the Database is 14 February 2026.

4.4 Age and weight categories:

Adults: 18 years and older:

Sports Sambo (men) – 58 kg, 64 kg, 71 kg, 79 kg, 88 kg, 98 kg, over 98 kg;

Sports Sambo (women)– 50 kg, 54 kg, 59 kg, 65 kg, 72 kg, 80 kg, over 80 kg;

Combat Sambo (men)– 58 kg, 64 kg, 71 kg, 79 kg, 88 kg, 98 kg, over 98 kg.

Combat Sambo (women)– 59 kg, 72 kg, over 72 kg.

Youth: 16-18 years old (born 2008 – 2010):

Sports Sambo (boys) – 53 kg, 58 kg, 64 kg, 71 kg, 79 kg, 88 kg, 98 kg, over 98 kg;

Sports Sambo (girls)– 47 kg, 50 kg, 54 kg, 59 kg, 65 kg, 72 kg, 80 kg, over 80 kg.

Cadets: 14-16 years old (born 2010 – 2012):

Sports Sambo (boys) – 46 kg, 49 kg, 53 kg, 58 kg, 64 kg, 71 kg, 79 kg, 88 kg, over 88 kg;

Sports Sambo (girls)– 41 kg, 44 kg, 47 kg, 50 kg, 54 kg, 59 kg, 65 kg, 72 kg, over 72 kg.

Kids: 13-14 years old (born 2012 – 2013):

Sports Sambo (boys) – 35 kg, 38 kg, 42 kg, 46 kg, 49 kg, 53 kg, 58 kg, 64 kg, over 64 kg;

Sports Sambo (girls)– 35 kg, 38 kg, 41 kg, 44 kg, 47 kg, 50 kg, 54 kg, 59 kg, over 59 kg.

Kids: 11-12 years old (born 2014 – 2015):

Sports Sambo (boys) – 32 kg, 35 kg, 38 kg, 42 kg, 46 kg, 49 kg, 53 kg, 58 kg, 64 kg, over 64 kg;

Sports Sambo (girls)– 32 kg, 35 kg, 38 kg, 41 kg, 44 kg, 47 kg, 50 kg, 54 kg, 59 kg, over 59 kg.

Kids: 8-10 years old (born 2016 – 2018):

Sports Sambo (boys & girls)– 30 kg, 32 kg, 35 kg, 38 kg, 41 kg, 44 kg, 47 kg, 50 kg, over 50 kg.

Masters: 35 years and older:

Sports Sambo (1991-1982) – 71 kg, 88 kg, over 88 kg;

Sports Sambo (1981 and older) – 71 kg, 88 kg, over 88 kg;

Note:

**Athletes of the kids age category may be admitted to participate in competitions among cadets (for admission the athlete must be born in 2012). Athletes of the cadet age category may be admitted to participate in competitions among youth (for admission, the athlete must be born in 2010). Athletes born in 2008 may be admitted to participate in competitions among adults, while registration in the SmoothComp Database occurs for each age category separately.*

***The weigh-in procedure is carried out in accordance with the program for each age category separately (if an athlete competes in two age categories, he must undergo the weigh-in procedure accordingly for each age category).*

**** categories with insufficient participation, will be put together.*

- 4.5 The delegation of each National Sambo Federation must bring at least 1 referee, if the number of athletes in the delegation exceeds 5 people (More referees are welcome!).

5. Technical specifications.

- 5.1 The Dutch Open SAMBO 2026 shall be held in accordance with the International SAMBO Competition Rules.
- 5.2 The draw will be conducted automatically.
- 5.3 Sport SAMBO official competitions shall be held with the system of distribution into groups, elimination and repechage bouts from finalists.
- 5.4 Combat SAMBO official competitions shall be held with the system of distribution into groups and elimination without repechage bouts.
- 5.5 Team medal count is conducted unofficially according to the Olympic principle (without awards).
- 5.6 The Organizing Committee guarantees to provide all the participants with first aid (if necessary).
- 5.7 Each athlete must undergo a medical examination before leaving for the competition, and the results of the medical examination must be included in the application or medical certificate.
- 5.8 Each athlete must provide to the accreditation commission a copy of life insurance policy against accidents (abroad). Insurance of the participants is carried out at the expense of the sending organizations.
- 5.9 Each athlete must have a sambo uniform (red/blue) with a FIAS license and a backnumber (in full compliance with FIAS requirements) on the back of his sambo uniform consisting of his surname and the abbreviation of his country's name or FIAS abbreviation as decided by FIAS.
- 5.10 Athletes who have discrepancies between the sambo uniform and the backnumber on the back of their uniform with the requirements of the FIAS International Rules are not allowed to participate in the competitions.

6. Visa applications.

- 6.1 All participants who require a visa to enter the Netherlands must apply for a visa at the Consular sections of the Embassy of the Netherlands in their country. The visa fee for entry to the Netherlands, which can be arranged for each participant, must be paid independently by the National Sambo Federation or the individual participant. The cost of the visa fee may vary from country to country. **Dutch Sambo Federation will provide the necessary visa support, subject to prior notification, until 15 January 2026.**
- 6.2 Applications for visa support shall be submitted to the Competition Organizing Committee in accordance with Annex No. 2.

7. Financial conditions.

- 7.1 Signing up obligates you to pay the registration fee.
- 7.2 The delegations have to pay the participation fee (if registered before 14th of February 2026) in the amount of € 25,00 per competitor.
- 7.3 In case of late registration (after 14th of February 2026) and if the registration is approved by the organization committee the participation fee will be raised with € 10,00 per competitor / discipline.
- 7.4 The organization committee does not provide accommodation. A list of possible accommodations for accommodating the delegation is provided in Annex No. 1.
- 7.5 All additional expenses are paid by each participant independently.
- 7.6 The Heads of Delegations shall settle all financial issues and meet accreditation requirements on the day of arrival.
